

THE NIGHTSHADE DUOLOGY GLOSSARY:

Aenge – An uncommon flower that grows along rivers, and carries a nectar that looks like blood

Alatum – Fallen angels whose wings have been severed by a blade with cursed steel

Amreloc aehter'nu – Eternal love

A'ryakai – A sect of angels who believe in a pure race; they hunt half breeds and demons

Av'adeih et paej – 'Go in peace' in Pri'scucian

Ba'nixium – A curse which binds one soul to another and prevents the cursed from committing murder

Bullio – a disease characterized by bone deformities and horrible lesions

Ca'ligo an a tua – Nephilim spell to cast away demons

Caelicolan – Language of the Nephilim

Cambion – Half human, half demon; can traverse planes; are immortal but can be mortally wounded; can be born cambion or turned

Casmal'zhaton – A painful form of torture experienced when agreement fails to be honored

Celestial steel – Steel forged by angels which can send any being to Ex Nihilo

Con'jeszis - The binding of souls, similar to marriage, but the bond cannot be broken.

Cret'calatięsz – Summoning chalk

Chthoniac – A potent demon liquor, lethal to humans

Contiszha – A demon contingency clause

Dalgoth – the only species of demon that resist and harvest vitaeilem

Dzilagion – a sea serpent that looks like a cross between a dragon and a snake

Diablisz steel – Steel forged by the Infernal which cannot be broken by any otherworldly being

Dojzra – Humans turned into immortal slaves in the Infernal Lands; they wear a slave band and answer to a demon overlord; can traverse planes and claim mortal souls

Dominus vigilans – The lord is watching

Dra'Akon – Humans granted special powers to protect mankind; their bloodline goes back to the ancients

Enchainsz – Binding another to sexual slavery without a collar; mindless and constant sex

Empyrean coin – Currency found in both Heaven and Hell

Empyrean Debenture – An official I.O.U.

Eradyę – The barren realm of starving souls; a place where angels cannot tread as they lose their powers

Es’ra – Echoes of a past life that may manifest imperfectly

Etheriusz – The protective layer, comprised of vitaeilem, which surrounds **Etheriana** (Heaven)

Ex Nihilo – The Nothingness from which everything was made – a plane devoid of life

Fallen – Angels who were banished from the heavens

Gratisz li’brunok – Unlimited freedom granted by Empyrean Debenture

Imolz era’da amreloc - The equivalent of I love you, but translates into *for my desired, I sacrifice*

Infernal Lands – Essentially Hell, where those who cannot be redeemed are sent. It is ruled by high ranking demons; can be easily traversed by demons and cambions; memories are retained as a means of torment.

Infernium – An asylum in Nightshade, formerly the location of an ancient temple

Inflodiusz – A command to fill

Intortui – Deformed beings, infected with bullion, who are able to predict future events

Ję’untis – A body whose soul is still attached

La’ruajh - A potent elixir that masks an angel’s vitaeilem

Ma’ baalirhya diszhra – My most treasured possession

Mę amreloc – A feeling beyond love

Me’reatrixis - A vulgar name for a female

Met’Lazan – A human chosen by the ancients with the power to translate the Omni and access vitaeilem in Etheriusz.

Mortesz ul’ Lilith – Death to Lilith

Mortunath – Soulless creatures who feed on souls and whose bite can turn others into Mortunath

Nephilim – Half human, half angel; can traverse planes; are immortal but can be mortally wounded; can be born Nephilim or turned (this is very rare)

Netherium – A kingdom found in the Infernal Lands

Noc’tu umbraj – Night + shadow = Nightshade

Noxerians – A very powerful demon council who oversee overlords in the various realms and answer to the Infernal Lord.

Omni – A dangerous sigil which can restore power and regenerate severed wings; it may also grant new powers to an individual

Omniasz – The all that makes up the existence of life in all realms

Overlords – High ranking fallen angels who rule Nightshade, collect taxes and carry out punishment

Pentacrux – The militant sect of the Pentasantorii

Pentasantorii – The Holy Five, consisting of the Holy Father, The Virgin Mother, The Messiah and the Two Warriors

Pentash – Female clergy

Pentash Mother – Similar to Reverend Mother; a high-ranking female clergy member

Pentrosh – Male clergy

Pentrosh Father – Similar to monsignor, a high-ranking clergymen in the Pentacrux

Praeceptia – An ancient city believed to have existed centuries ago that mysteriously disappeared

Pri'scucian - A language that predates Enochian – the true ancient language of angels

Rur'axze – A demon's intense and sometimes painful need to be sated

Saericasz – Refers to a divine fruit that has an addicting quality and can be eaten to the point of death; a demon euphemism for vagina

Sang âysh'la cin'tchinez – Blood of five blades

Sentinel – Half demon, half angel; powerful beings who often work undercover to infiltrate the demons realm

Septier – A gift of seven

Seraphica – a potent drug made from angels' blood that mimics vitaeilem

Sigiliuz de'tei – A Pri'scucian grimoire containing the most forbidden magic

Stre vera'tu – As real as the stars

Sybil – Prophetesses or oracles who have the power of foresight

Tę nebrisz – A soul's dark energy

Tu'Nazhja – A bird whose song is so beautiful, it lures its prey to death

Vale – The barrier between the mortal realm and Nightshade

Venator - Assigned huntsmen in a village

Vinculum – A mental bond between animal and angels/demons

Vitaeilem – the life blood of angels

Vocatori – A summoner
